Who can be identified under McKinney-Vento?

A family or student living in any of the following situations:

- Unsheltered (car, park, etc)
- Emergency Shelter
- Motel/Hotel
- Doubled Up
- Supportive Housing
- Unaccompanied Youth (youth not in the legal custody of a parent/guardian)

We may be able to HELP with:

- Transportation (to/from school, school activities)
- Before/Afterschool Care (Cub Care, Boys & Girls Club, Girls Inc)
- School Supplies (including headphones)
- Hygiene Supplies
- Tutoring
- Internet Hotspot
